 - Internet Explorer 7.0 or above
 - Flash Player 10.1 or above









Click "**Download**" for the required software.




It will direct you to the Adobe Flash Player download page. Click "**Agree and Install now**".







If a warning message is shown on the top, click on it and click **"Install ActiveX Control..."**.




Click **"Install"**.



A message will be displayed when the installation is completed.




Click "Press Here After You Have Installed All Plug-ins."

Appendix 2

How to Disable "Popup-Blocker" Feature in Toolbars?

Google Toolbar

1. Open your Internet Explorer
2. Find **Google Toolbar** under your Internet Explorer
3. Find **Settings** button on the Google Toolbar > Click **Options...**
4. Find **More** tab
5. Find **Enable Pop-up Blocker** and uncheck it (Disable Pop-up Blocker)
6. Click **OK** to save and exit

Yahoo! Toolbar

1. Open your Internet Explorer
2. Find **Yahoo! Toolbar** under your Internet Explorer
3. Find **Pop-up Blocker** button on the Yahoo! Toolbar
4. Find **Enable Pop-up Blocker** and uncheck it (Disable Pop-up Blocker)

Crawler Toolbar

- It is recommended to uninstall this toolbar from your computer.

Conflict of Toolbars

If you have both Google and Yahoo! "Toolbars", it is recommended to uninstall one of them to avoid potential conflict between both toolbars.


How Can I Change the Screen Resolution on the Computer? (For Window XP Version)

1. To change the screen resolution, users should log in to the administration account of your computer operation system (Window XP), and then follow the instructions below.




2. Right click on the space area on the desktop and there will be a menu.

3. Choose the last option – **Properties**.




4. There will be a five-tab window (**Display Properties**) jumping out after the click.



5. Choose the last tab – **Settings**.

6. Set the **screen resolution** to be **1024 x 768** pixels.



7. Click **OK**.



8. You may find the icons on your desktop look smaller after the adjustment.
